Q: How do COAST donations work?

A: Students will bring items collected to their Bruin Teacher, teachers will keep a tally of which pod items are coming from.

Q: What does COAST stand for?

A: It is a community service organization. Not exactly sure what it stands for. They meet twice a month and determine what service projects to work on. 7th and 8th graders are eligible. At the end of 6th grade, you can apply to be a COAST member. There is an application process. They are looking for kids who have leadership, a history of good actions and good character, and can take the lead. They also look for recommendations from teachers.

Q: Where do students drop of box tops?

A: Students can put them in the drop box by the office or give them to their Bruin Teacher. There isn't a competition, so who they give the box tops to does not matter.

Q: Where do the bumper stickers / magnets come from? Could BMS sell them?

A: The high school sells them from their school store. They are part of the business program and part of the curriculum for students at the high school. It is too large an undertaking for a single person, but if anyone were interested in bringing these items to BMS, they could discuss it with Kim Radford who runs the program at Blacksburg High School.
